The poster boards will be numbered accordingly to the abstract book.

Due to limited space available for posters, the presenters are kindly asked to follow the schedule for poster mounting. Posters for sessions I, II, III, VI and LBA should be mounted on the 7th of July and removed no later than 15.30 on the 9th of July. Posters for sessions IV, V and VII should be mounted starting from 15.30 on the 9th of July.

Please note that the posters which have not been removed by their presenters will be moved to the Information Desk where they can be picked up.

The organizers will provide all the accessories needed for poster mounting.
